

Joe Tomecek





The IRS now permits taxpayers to claim a deduction on their federal income tax returns for cash contributions they make to certain qualifying charitable organizations like West Towns Chorus even if they don't itemize their deductions. The maximum deduction is \$600 for married individuals filing joint returns.

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD)

Taxpayers over age 70½ can also make a qualified charitable distribution, up to \$100,000, directly from their IRA to a qualified charitable organization like West Towns Chorus. That donation would be considered a nontaxable RMD distribution if the IRA trustee sent the amount directly to West Towns Chorus. This small flask lasted for eight days, giving them time to purify more. In order to commemorate this miracle, Jews light a Menorah for the eight days of Chanukah.
